Nose Gear Steering By-Pass Pin

During a recent SACA audit, inspectors found the towing lever support damaged.



The photo clearly shows that this support is completely torn apart and detached from the towing box.

The towing lever support serves to keep the lever in the "No-Towing" position.

The picture below illustrates where the support is installed in the towing box and its role in maintaining the lever in the diagonal position.
