DESTINATION USA - Destination Address

The U.S. Immigration Authorities (CBP – U.S. Customs and Border Protection) have recently notified the Airline that a significant number of passenger data entries transmitted for flights to the **United States** are being submitted incorrectly.

Please note that all passenger information transmitted to U.S. authorities is constantly monitored. The transmission of inaccurate or incomplete data may lead to penalties or fines being imposed on the airline by U.S. Immigration authorities.




For this reason, all staff involved in passenger handling and data entry must ensure that **all passenger data entered during the check-in process**, as well as the **Destination Address information (mandatory for non-US nationals only)**, are inserted accurately and completely, based on the information provided by the passenger.

In Altea CM, please pay particular attention to the following fields in the **Destination Address section** of the Travel Information mask:


- ❖ Country
- ❖ Street Information
- ❖ City
- ❖ State
- ❖ Post Code

Each field must be completed accurately and must correspond to the passenger's **first address in the United States**, as required by U.S. Immigration regulations.

Below are some examples of correct and incorrect entries in the **Destination Address section** of the Altea CM Travel Information mask.

The “International Transit” indicator shall **only** be selected as “**YES**” when passengers are transiting to another Country within the next few hours.



Please review these examples carefully and ensure that all future entries are completed in accordance with these guidelines.
