The purpose of this immigration bulletin is to provide a monthly snapshot of significant regulatory updates with respect to entry requirements and common errors recorded while performing document verification during our operations. It aims at promoting awareness, minimizing the risk of future operational issues at airports, and reducing fines and costs associated to possible mistakes.

DESTINATION USA

1. BORDER CROSSING CARD

Enter the Border Crossing Card number found in the MRZ (Machine Readable Zone) of the document as per sample below. Number **must** include 3 letter city code and 9 digits. This is the **only** number that can be used for matching. Country of issuance is **always USA**.



2. U.S. VISA

We remind you that the VISA number, to be manually inserted in the DCS during check-in process, is the **red foil number** found towards the bottom right of the VISA as per sample below.

Country of issuance is ***always*** USA.



REMINDER: The traveler must have the U.S. visa or other U.S. entry document in their possession, regardless of the Document Validation response. Photocopies are also not acceptable. Please verify the physical document for all travelers.
