

Security Department - Aviation Security Immigration Bulletin – 4 June 2024

The purpose of this immigration bulletin is to provide a monthly snapshot of significant regulatory updates with respect to entry requirements and common errors recorded while performing document verification during our operations. It aims at promoting awareness, minimizing the risk of future operational issues at airports, and reducing fines and costs associated to possible mistakes.

DESTINATION GHANA

In view of the opening of ITA Airways operations to Ghana, here below the main highlights on entry regulations in the Country.

Citizens of EU countries and North America are requested to hold:

- **Passport**, valid on arrival;

Exemption: Dual Nationals of Ghana with a national ID card issued by Ghana.

- **VISA**.

Vaccination against yellow fever is requested, exempt for children under 9 months and adults above 60 years.

Weapons and ammunitions are restricted items and can only be imported after issuance of a special permit by the Ghanaian Ministry of Interior.

Baggage is cleared at first airport of entry in Ghana with the exemption of baggage of transit passengers with a destination outside of Ghana as far as passengers do not leave the terminal.

We remind you that failing on checking immigration regulations or accepting passengers with irregular documentation may lead to passengers' entry refusal and fines to ITA Airways.
