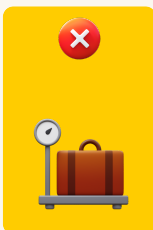


Baggage Control Rules

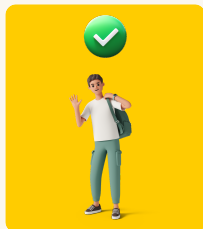
Rule 1: Size is checked.
Weight is not checked.



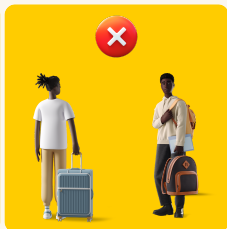
When a guest who has bought a light package arrives at the gate with a single piece, **the size of the item is checked**, not its weight.



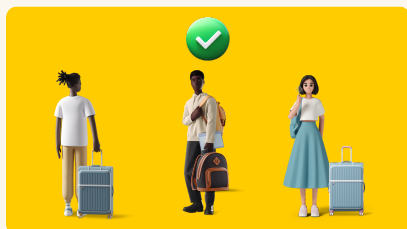
Rule 2: Guests with light package can only bring 1 personal item.



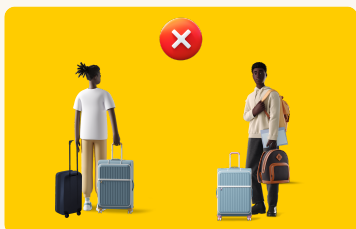
Guests who have purchased a **light package** can come to the gate with **only one piece of personal belongings**. If they come with a trolley sized bag or 2 or more items, **a penalty will be applied for each extra item**.



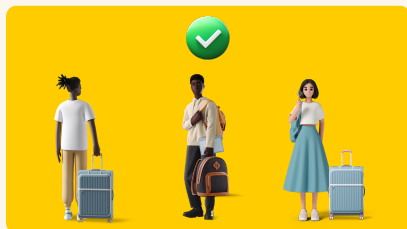
Rule 3: The passenger who has cabin baggage allowance can come to the gate with a maximum of 2 pieces



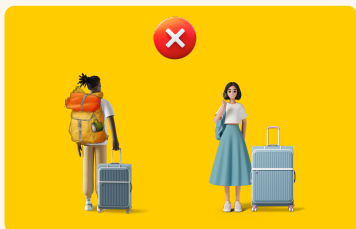
Passengers who **have cabin baggage allowance** can come to the gate with a **maximum of 2 pieces**. **A penalty is applied for each extra piece**.



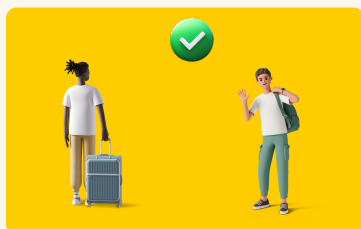
Rule 4: Penalties apply for large items exceeding the cabin baggage dimensions, even if the number of pieces is appropriate.



Although the guest with cabin baggage allowance arrives at the gate with 2 pieces, if one of the pieces is **significantly larger than the cabin baggage dimensions**, **a penalty is applied**.



Rule 5: Passengers who bring their under-flight baggage to the gate will be penalized.



If a passenger with **under-flight baggage** allowance **brings this baggage to the gate**, **a penalty will be applied**.
