

ACCEPTANCE OF RIDEABLE BAGGAGE ON FLIGHTS

TO : ALL STATIONS
FROM : GROUND OPERATIONS

Dear Partners,

Starting October 20, 2025, rideable baggage will be accepted on our flights under the following conditions.

1. Rideable Baggage as Cabin Baggage

- The lithium metal content must not exceed 2 grams, and lithium-ion batteries must not exceed 100 Wh.
- The battery must be removed from the baggage and carried separately in the cabin.
- The removed battery must not be re-inserted into the baggage or charged during the flight or until arrival at the destination.
- The battery must be protected against short circuits by one of the following methods:
 - Carried in its original packaging,
 - With terminals insulated, or
 - Stored in a protective plastic case.

2. Rideable Baggage as Checked Baggage

- The lithium battery must be removed from the baggage and carried in the cabin by the passenger.
- The battery must be protected against short circuits as described above.
- Rideable baggage containing a battery (not removed) will not be accepted as checked baggage.

Batteries without clear information or valid certification will not be accepted for transport.
