E-VISA PROCESS FOR RESIDENTS WITH A UK RESIDENCE PERMIT

- The UK stopped physical residence cards (BRP/BRC cards) and move to a fully electronic visa (e-visa) system from 1 January 2025. This change will make it easier to manage and verify the residence permits of passengers traveling to the UK digitally.

WHO WILL NEED AN E-VISA?



- All BRP (Biometric Residence Permit) / BRC (Biometric Residence Permit) residence card holders,
- Holders of type D visas granting long-term stay rights.

- **Valid consular (sticker) visas, entry clearance visas, and indefinite stamp residence permits inside passports** will continue to be used.

E-VISA PROCESS FOR RESIDENTS WITH A UK RESIDENCE PERMIT

- Residence permit holders will no longer be able to use their physical cards starting from January 1, 2025. Instead, they must register with the UKVI (UK Visas and Immigration) system to view and manage their residence permit information.
- Our passengers need to create a digital account for the registration process at www.gov.uk/evisa. The steps to create a digital account are explained on the next page.





DIGITAL TRANSITION PROCESS FOR WORK, EDUCATION AND FAMILY VISAS

- As part of the second phase of the UK's digital transition, effective from 30 October 2025:
 - ❖ For **work, study, and family visas**, as well as **settlement (indefinite leave to enter/remain)** applications, **entry clearance vignettes will no longer be placed in passports**. (The production of these visa types in sticker format will be discontinued.)
 - ❖ Passengers under these categories will **travel using eVisas only**.
 - ❖ Their permission to travel will be confirmed through the system-generated message "**0A – Valid Permission to Travel**."
- Points to Note During Document Checks:
 - ✓ Passengers for whom a "**0A – Valid Permission to Travel**" message is received **have valid permission to travel to the UK** — no additional visa check is required.
 - ✓ Ensure that all passengers hold a **valid passport** and that **documents are genuine and belong to the rightful holder**.
 - ✓ If the "**0A – Valid Permission to Travel**" message is **not received**, the passenger may:
 - Present a **valid physical visa/vignette**, or
 - Share a **Share Code**, which can be verified through the "**Check Someone's Immigration Status**" service.

Summary of what they can do in the UK

They can:

- live in the UK until 24 May 2026
- study with their licensed sponsor, subject to [Academic Technology Approval Scheme \(ATAS\) conditions](#)
- use the National Health Service (NHS) in a similar way to permanent UK residents
- access a current account with a bank or building society in the UK
- travel in and out of the country

ELECTRONIC TRAVEL AUTHORIZATION (ETA)

- ETA will become mandatory for passengers who previously traveled visa-free to the UK but do not hold a residence permit.
- **This rules includes passengers visiting the UK directly or transiting through the country.**
- **Hard copy ETAs will not be accepted.** The ETA must be presented digitally.

WHO WILL NEED AN ETA?

- As of February 25, 2026, the transition to ETA will end, and **ETA will become mandatory for citizens of all countries who have the right to travel to the UK without a visa** (except citizens of the United Kingdom and Ireland). This passengers will be allowed to board flights until this date even if they do not have ETA.
- Passengers subject to ETA will **still be required to obtain an ETA even if they are using the UK for transit purposes** (without passing through border control).

- **UK and Irish citizens and diplomatic passport holders who can travel to the UK without a visa are exempt from the ETA requirement.**

0A Cleared to board VALID PERMISSION TO TRAVEL

- This response indicates that the passenger has a registered visa or residence permit in the system.
- In this case, you do not need to check a visa or residence permit.
- However, forgery and imposter checks on the passport should still be performed.

Citizens of countries that require a visa

The passenger must be checked to determine whether they hold a valid physical travel permission document. The documents that can be accepted as valid are:

- Valid immigration status
- Valid BRC (Biometric Residence Card)
- Indefinite stamped residence permit
- Indefinite leave to remain sticker
- Visa sticker

 If the passenger has any of the documents listed above;
→ They are **accepted for travel**.

 If the guest does not have any of the documents listed above;
→ They are **not accepted for travel**.

Citizens of countries that do not require a visa

The passenger must be checked to determine whether they hold a valid physical travel permission document. The documents that can be accepted as valid are:

- EUSS (EU Settlement Scheme)
- Valid BRC (Biometric Residence Card)
- Indefinite stamped residence permit
- Indefinite leave to remain sticker
- Visa sticker

 If the passenger has any of the documents listed above;
→ They are **accepted for travel**.


 If the guest does not have any of the documents listed above;
→ They are **not accepted for travel**. The related passenger must apply for an ETA.

- When the passenger re-applies at the counter after the initial application, the system performs a new query.
- If the response to the new check returns as “**0A**”, then → **The passenger is accepted for travel**.

0B Response Scenarios

Scenario 1 – Turkish Citizen (visa nationals)

- **System Response:** 0B
- Residence permit / vignette visa is **checked manually**.
 - **If the passenger has a valid residence permit or vignette visa:**
- **Result:** The passenger is accepted for travel with **0B** response.



Scenario 2 - German Citizen (non-visa nationals)

- **System Response:** 0B
- Residence permit / vignette visa is checked manually.
 - **If the passenger has a valid residence permit or vignette visa:**
 - **If the passenger does NOT have a valid residence permit or vignette visa:**
 - The passenger is informed that they must apply for an ETA.
 - Check-in and boarding procedures are not completed.
 - **Result:** The passenger is not accepted for travel.
 - **After the ETA Application:**
 - If the passenger re-applies at the counter after submitting the ETA application, a new APP check is performed in the system. If the result of this new check is **0A – Cleared to Board / VALID PERMISSION TO TRAVEL**:
 - **Result:** The passenger is accepted for travel with the **0A** response.



DIGITAL TRANSITION PROCESS FOR REFUGEE PASSPORTS ISSUED BY THE UK

- **As of January 28, 2026**, for passengers travelling with the below-listed refugee travel documents issued by the United Kingdom, the system response “0B – No Record of Valid Permission to Travel” will be received. **In this case, there is no requirement to perform a visa or residence permit check. However, passport and imposter checks must continue to be carried out.**
- **As of February 25, 2026**, the response “0A – Cleared to Board – VALID PERMISSION TO TRAVEL” will be received for these passengers. This response should be accepted as evidence that the passenger holds a valid immigration status in the United Kingdom. **In this case, there is no requirement to perform a visa or residence permit check. However, passport fraud and likeness checks must continue to be carried out.**
- *UK Refugee Travel Document*
- *UK Stateless Persons Travel Document*
- *UK Certificate of Travel*



This procedure does not apply to travel documents issued by other countries. If the “0A” response is received, there is no requirement to perform a visa or residence permit check. However, passport forgery and imposter checks must continue to be conducted. If the “0B” response is received, manual checks must be performed.

0Z Cleared to Board

- This control response applies only to citizens of the **United Kingdom and Ireland**.
- Passengers will be allowed to board the flight after passport checks for **forgery and similarity** have been completed.
