

# Main Screen




Assigned flights are displayed to Personnel.






Added hidden pull-down quick search feature in the application. The user will be able to show the search area by swiping down and destroy it by swiping up.

# Settings




It is possible to work with simpler screens by closing the areas that are not needed in the application. Personal screens can be created. As all data is critical, the use of some roles is personal.




Front detail screen of the flights open with this arrow.

# LS View and Confirm




When a new LS is created from Pades, the red alert flashes and clicking this field opens the LS page. Approval/rejection processes can be managed directly from here.



All statuses including LS's approval by the captain can be viewed here. Clicking on it opens the LS screen.

# Detailed Screen






If the Arrival Leg of any flight is clicked on the "All Flights" screen, Arrival Detail, if the Departure Leg is clicked, the Departure detail screen is opened.

All areas are closed at the first opening, with the drill down structure, more details can be obtained if needed.

It is possible to switch between Arrival and Departure detail screens.
