Dear All,

According to requirements of Pegasus Airlines Air Carrier Security Program Chapter 4.10.4.6;

The PG-GU-FR-011 - Potentially Disruptive Passenger Information Form must be completed by the Passenger Service Agents for INAD, Deportee, Denied Boarding Passengers and Persons in Lawful Custody.

Upon the approval of the Pilot in Command, a copy of this form shall be handed over to the Senior Cabin Crew along with the other documents.

We would like to remind you that, in the absence of the Potential Risk Passenger Form (PG-GU-FR-011), the passenger **shall not be accepted for the flight**. In addition, we kindly ask you to pay attention to the following points:

- In accordance with the revisions made in the PG-GU-FR-011 - Potentially Disruptive Passenger Form (Rev.2 - 16.08.2024), PG-DO-EK-001 Ground Operations Manual, and PG-DO-BK-002 – Ground Operations Quick Reference documents;
 - **INAD Passenger** notifications shall be sent to GUESTCONTROL@flypgs.com and INAD@flypgs.com,
 - **Escorted INAD (ENAD)** notifications shall be sent to SECURITY@flypgs.com, PEGASUSVISA@flypgs.com and GUESTCONTROL@flypgs.com and,
 - **Persons in Lawful Custody and/or Escorted Deportee (DEPA)** notifications shall be sent to SECURITY@flypgs.com at least before 24 hours the flight, and **approval shall be obtained**.
