SUBJECT : Use of Electronic Format for Aircraft Security Search Information Form

Dear Partners,

We would like to inform you about an update in our procedures for managing Aircraft Security Search Forms. In line with Pegasus Airlines Air Carrier Security Program and relevant international regulations (ECAC Document 30 and EU Implementing Regulation 2015/1998), the form PG-GU-FR-001 – Aircraft Security Search Information Form is now stored electronically in the Electronic Flight Bag (EFB) system.

In this context;

- Except in case of system failure, the Aircraft Security Search Information Form will no longer be maintained in paper format. Thus, you are not required to store physical copies of the Aircraft Security Search Information Form.
- All records will be securely stored and accessible in the Electronic Flight Bag for an indeterminate duration.
- These records can be provided for inspection by the authorities upon request to Pegasus Airlines Security Department.

We kindly ask you to ensure that all relevant personnel in your organization are made aware of this procedural update. Additionally, please ensure that this information is shared with the relevant authorities during security inspections.
