General Rules

- **Residence permits and Schengen visas issued by Schengen member countries do not grant the right to travel to Ireland.**
- There are exemptions for certain visas issued by the United Kingdom, explained on the following pages (Page 6).
- All passengers travelling to Ireland, including Irish citizens, **must have valid travel documents upon arrival.**
- Passengers under the age of 16 can enter Ireland without a visa if one of their parents holds a valid residence permit and they are traveling together.
- **There is no transit facility at [Dublin Airport](#) ; therefore, passengers with onward flights must also meet the entry requirements to Ireland.**

Passport and Residence Permit




Stamps

- The stamps below are issued to passengers at the Irish border in accordance with the purpose of their travel. The date of entry into Ireland and the date of departure are written manually on the stamp. **The relevant stamp does not grant travel rights.**



Travelling with a UK Visa

- Residence permits issued by the United Kingdom do not grant the right to travel to Ireland.
- **180-day Type C visas issued by the United Kingdom allow the visa holder to travel to Ireland, provided that the holder has entered the United Kingdom at least once and the visa is valid.** (This rule varies for each country's citizen. Eligibility should be verified through the Timatic.)
- **To travel to Ireland on this visa, the holder must have entered the UK within 180 days prior to the date of travel.**
