E-VISA PROCESS FOR RESIDENTS WITH A UK RESIDENCE PERMIT

- Starting from **January 1, 2025**, the United Kingdom will **stop using physical residence cards (BRP/BRC cards)** and move to a completely **electronic visa (e-visa)** system. This change will make it easier to manage and verify the residence permits of passengers traveling to the UK digitally.
- Exemption:** BRP/BRC residence cards expiring on or after **December 31, 2024**, will remain valid for physical use until **March 31, 2025**. Even if the passenger's share code indicates that they are not authorized to travel to the UK, they can still be accepted for the flight if they have a BRP/BRC card that expired on or after December 31.

WHO WILL NEED AN E-VISA?



- All BRP (Biometric Residence Permit) / BRC (Biometric Residence Permit) residence card holders,
- Holders of type D visas granting long-term stay rights.

- Valid consular (sticker) visas, entry clearance visas, and indefinite stamp residence permits inside passports will continue to be used.

E-VISA PROCESS FOR RESIDENTS WITH A UK RESIDENCE PERMIT

- Residence permit holders will no longer be able to use their physical cards starting from January 1, 2025. Instead, they will need to register with the **UKVI (UK Visas and Immigration)** system to view and manage their residence permit information.
- **Exemption:** BRP/BRC residence cards expiring on or after December 31, 2024, will remain valid for physical use until March 31, 2025.
- Our passengers need to create a digital account for the registration process at www.gov.uk/evisa. The steps to create a digital account are explained on the next page.

SAMPLE CASES

Sample Case (1): The physical residence card of a passenger who wants to travel to the UK on January 3, 2025 expired before December 31, 2024.

Answer: The passenger must present the residence permit digitally **since the physical residence card expired before December 31, 2024.**

Sample Case (2): The physical residence card of a passenger who wants to travel to the UK on January 3, 2025 has expired on December 31, 2024.

Answer: The passenger **is not required to present the residence permit digitally since the physical residence card expired on December 31, 2024.** Even if the card has expired, the passenger **can use this card physically until March 31, 2025.**

Sample Case (3): The physical residence card of a passenger who wants to travel to the UK on January 3, 2025 has expired on January 2, 2025.

Answer: The passenger **is not required to present the residence permit digitally since the physical residence card expired on or after December 31, 2024.** Even if the card has expired, the passenger **can use this card physically until March 31, 2025.**

STEPS TO CREATE A DIGITAL ACCOUNT

View and prove your immigration status: get a share code

You can use this service to:

- get a 'share code' to prove your status to others, for example employers
- update personal details in your UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI) account, for example your passport number or email address
- check what rights you have in the UK, for example the right to work, rent or claim benefits

Who can use this service

You can only use this service if you have a UKVI account.

You'll have a UK Visas and Immigration account if you've ever:

- applied to the EU Settlement Scheme
- used the 'UK Immigration: ID Check' app to prove your identity when applying for a visa
- created one when applying for a visa (you'll have received a UKVI account confirmation email)
- created one to get access to an eVisa (an online record of your immigration status)

If you do not have a UKVI account

There are different services to [prove your right to work](#) to an employer and to [prove your right to rent](#) to a landlord.

You'll need:

- details of the identity document you use to sign in to your UKVI account (your passport, national identity card, or biometric residence card or permit)
- your date of birth
- access to the mobile number or email address you use to sign in to your UKVI account - you'll be sent a code for signing in

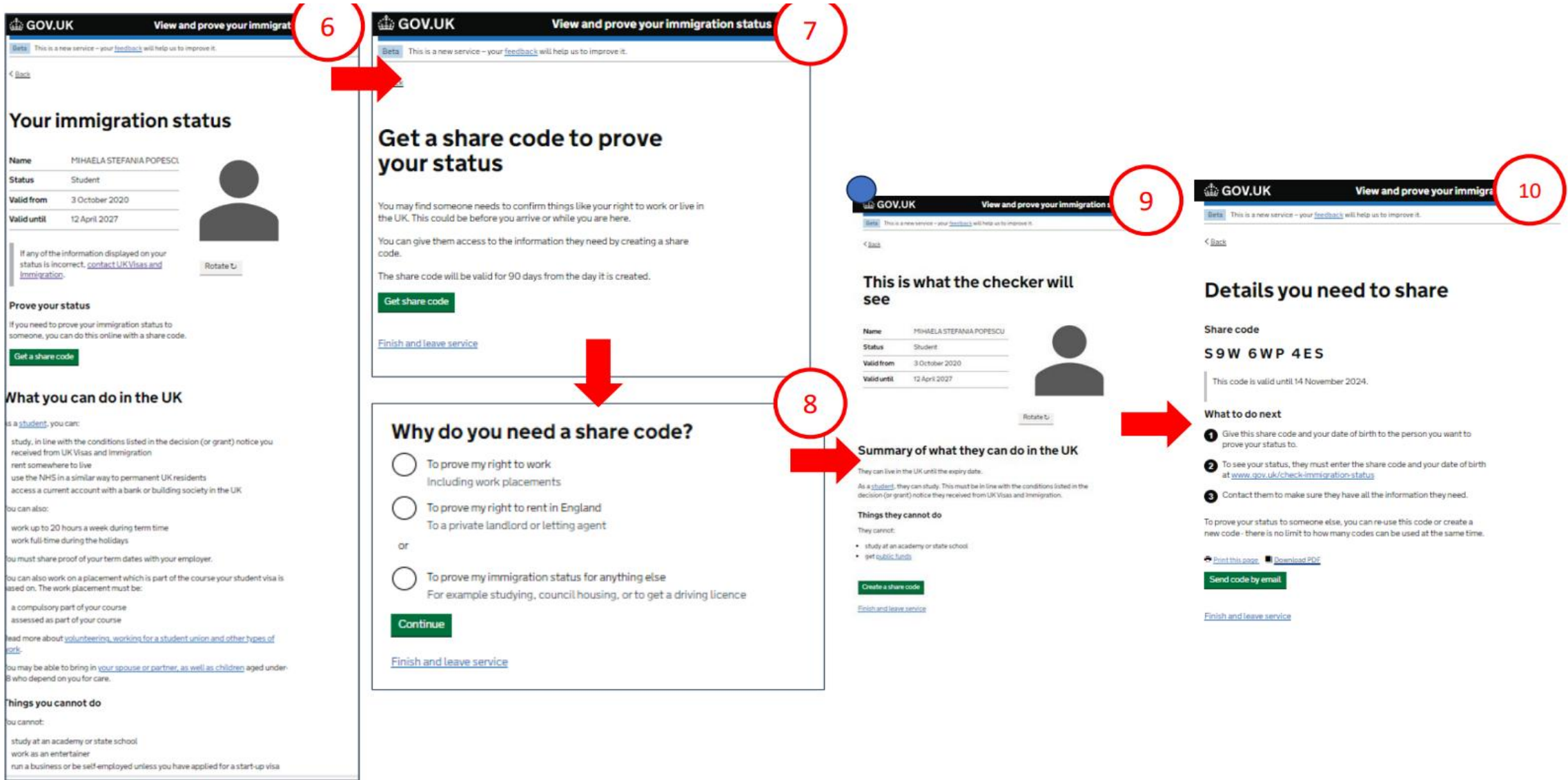

STEPS TO CREATE A DIGITAL ACCOUNT AND SHARE CODE



ELECTRONIC TRAVEL AUTHORIZATION (ETA)

- ETA will become mandatory for passengers who previously traveled visa-free to the UK but do not hold a residence permit.
- **This rules includes passengers visiting the UK directly or transiting through the country.**
- **Hard copy ETAs will not be accepted.** The ETA must be presented digitally.

WHO WILL NEED AN ETA?

- ✈ **Passengers who can currently visit the UK visa-free** (excluding European citizens) can apply for an ETA starting **November 27, 2024**. The application will start on **January 8, 2025**. **However, until further notice, passengers who have not applied for an ETA will still be allowed on the flight. However, passengers are advised to apply for an ETA as soon as possible.**
- ✈ ETA applications for **citizens of European countries** will begin on **March 5, 2025**, and will become mandatory on **April 2, 2025**.
- ✈ Passengers subject to ETA will **still be required to obtain an ETA even if they are using the UK for transit purposes** (without passing through border control).

- **UK and Irish citizens and diplomatic passport holders who can travel to the UK without a visa are exempt from the ETA requirement.**

SYSTEM RESPONSES

0A Cleared to board VALID PERMISSION TO TRAVEL : This response indicates that **the passenger has a registered visa or residence permit in the system.** In this case, you do not need to check a visa or residence permit. However, **forgery and similarity checks on the passport should still be performed.**

- access a current account with a bank or building society in the UK
- travel in and out of the country
