Dear Service Providers and Business Partners,

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic many countries around the world are announcing restrictions.

We would like to keep you updated with the latest restrictions affecting LOT Polish Airlines flights.

Below you will find the table containing information about testing/registration required for acceptance on LOT flights.

The country in this table is the country (airport) of destination.

Please be aware that it only applies to the entry requirements related to COVID-19 (non-immigration).

Please check if the transfer at WAW is allowable.

A combination of vaccines is accepted. The certificate must be in ENG or JPN or accompanied by a certified ENG or JPN translation.		Covid-19 test MUST include following words <u>with no alternatives</u> : "nasopharyngeal/rhinopharyngeal swab" or "saliva" or "nasopharyngeal and oropharyngeal swab" or "nasal swab" if test type is LAMP, NEAR, PCR, SMART AMP, TMA, TRC. no misspellings allowed.
USA				exemptions from vaccine - nationals and residents of USA, pax with immigrant visa, children <18 years old, NATIONALS OF UKRAINE WITH TRAVEL AUTHORIZATION (U4U), doctor's letter proving pax is unable to receive vaccine, seamen with C-1/D visa, US military personel, dead head crew, <u>other exemptions in timatic/cdc website</u>	Passengers must have a COVID-19 vaccination certificate showing that they were fully vaccinated at least 15 days (day of vaccination + 14 days) before arrival. Accepted vaccines: ASTRAZENECA, COVAXIN,CONVIDECIA, COVISHIELD, COVOVAX, JANSSEN, MODERNA, NUVAXOVID (NOVAVAX), PFIZER-BIONTECH, SINOPHARM AND SINOVAC. A COMBINATION OF THESE VACCINES IS ACCEPTED IF ADMINISTERED AT LEAST 17 DAYS APART.
