Details

New processes and procedures have been put in place to aid the operation during the Olympic (26/07/24 – 11/08/24) and Paralympic (28/08/24 – 08/09/24) games. As well as outlining new processes, this document includes current procedures, policy and guidance that will be particularly relevant at this time.

This guide should be referred to as a high-level refresher for these processes, and the relevant guidance material has been referenced to help Ground Crew get more in-depth detail. The Olympics 2024 are due to take place in Paris from the 26 th of July to the 11 th of August. The Paralympics are due to be taking place from the 28 th August to the 9 th of September.
