### ATTENTION:

#### ACB is switched off before the engines have fully spooled down

This Safety Alert is issued to raise awareness of the increased risk to ground personnel due to a change in Flight Crew procedures.

Following a recent change to the TUI Flight Crew Shutdown procedure, the Anti-Collision Beacon (ACB) is switched off much earlier than before the change - normally 3-4 seconds after fuel is cut off to the engines.

This means that the engines are still rotating at a high speed when the ACB is switched off. In accordance with GOM 4.1.3, personnel must not approach the aircraft until the engines are confirmed to be spooling down to a safe speed and the ACB is switched off.
