### Cooling/Heating Units and Preconditioned Air

**Danger:** Before supplying cooling or heating air by an external source, you **MUST** notify the flight crew and obtain approval as the aircraft would need to be configured for Pre-Conditioned Air intake (PACKS off), otherwise damage to aircraft equipment will occur and make sure that at least one cabin access door is open and remains open during air unit operation.

As part of the fuel conservation programs of most airlines, pre-conditioned air is required at all airports that provide on-stand pre-conditioned air.
