Dear partner,

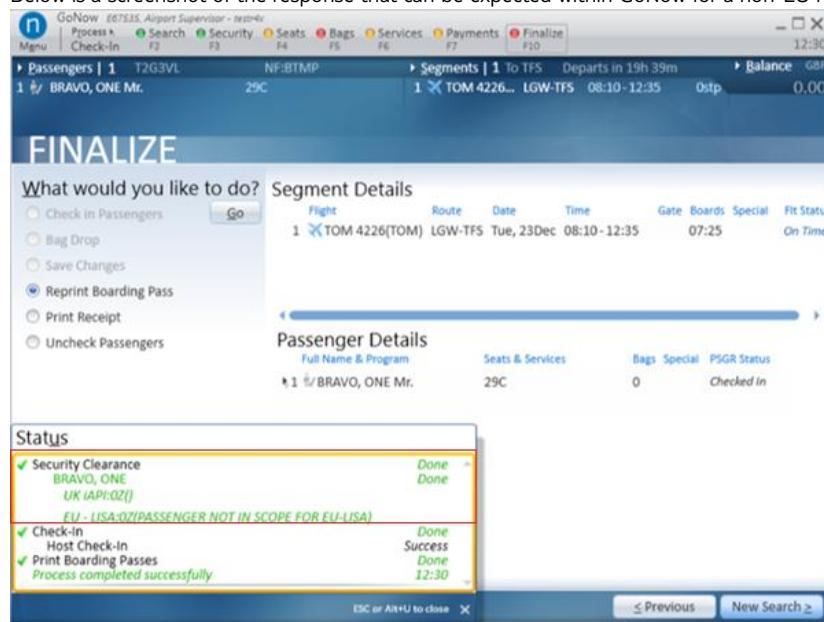
As part of the **EU-LISA program**, the **Entry/Exit System (EES)** will become mandatory starting **April 2026**. To ensure a **smooth transition** and **operational readiness**, we are now entering a **non-mandatory implementation period**.

Starting **13 January 2026**, **EES checks** will be introduced within **GoNow during check-in** for all applicable flights. This marks the **beginning of the phased rollout** of mandatory EES checks across the Schengen area.

## Key points for this phase:

- GoNow will automatically query the details of the passenger against the EES database upon check-in.
- The EES check at check-in within GoNow will be introduced in a phased approach as of **13 January**, with rollout timing varying by route.
- During the voluntary period, which lasts **until 9 April 2026**, **all passengers** will receive either an EE (Passenger exempt) or a OZ code (Passenger not in scope) as EES status during check-in. This applies to both EU and non-EU passengers.
- This voluntary period is intended for **system testing and operational readiness** before full EES integration.
- If during check-in any disruption or technical issue related to EES is encountered, **TOCC must be contacted immediately** via the normal procedure.
- During this voluntary period, no additional action is required from check-in agents other than monitoring and reporting any irregularities.

Below is a screenshot of the response that can be expected within GoNow for a non-EU national upon check-in.

# EU Entry/Exit System (EES)

The **Entry/Exit System (EES)** is an EU border management solution designed to automate the registration of non-EU travellers entering or leaving the Schengen Area.

## Key Functions

- ✈ **Replaces manual passport stamping** with a secure digital process and biometric verification
- ✈ **Digitally records** entry and exit dates for short-stay travellers
- ✈ **Captures biometric data** (facial image and fingerprints) during first registration
- ✈ **Enhances security** by detecting overstays and identity fraud
- ✈ **Speeds up future crossings** through automated gates and facial recognition
- ✈ Applicable to **all Schengen external borders** for non-EU nationals



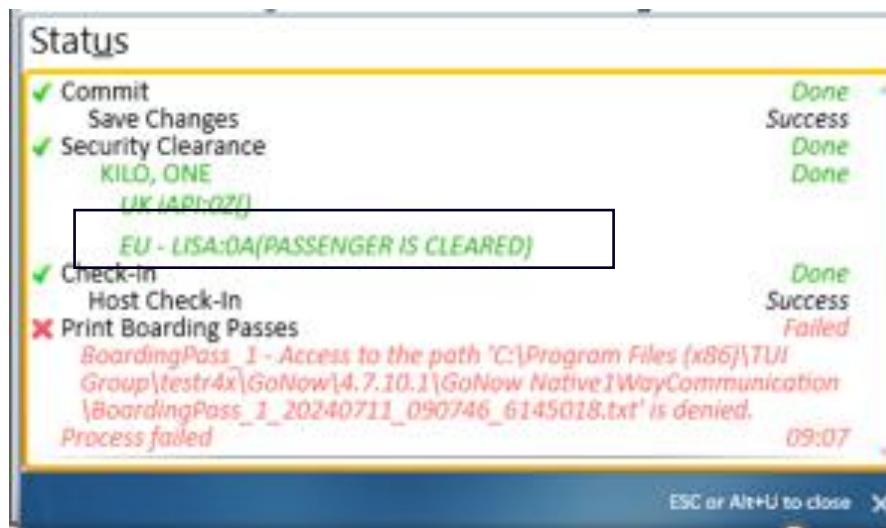
# Passenger Security Status – EES Response Codes

When a passenger is checked in within 48hrs of departure, the **Entry/Exit System (EES)** generates an **interactive response** that determines the passenger's clearance status.

This status determines whether the passenger is:

Approved for travel

 Requires additional checks before clearance



Code	Meaning
0A	 Cleared for travel – OK EES
0Z	 Not in scope for EES – NA EES
0D	 No permission found – NOK EES
00%	 Auto-Outage Clearance
TT%	 System Timeout

## Action Required

- Passengers with **0A** or **0Z** may proceed with check-in.
- Passengers with **0D** require manual documentation checks; if cleared, they can be processed manually.
- For **TT%** response, follow the procedure on the next page.

# EES Outage – GoNow Triggered

## Step-by-Step Guide

### ✈ TT (timeout) error occurs

- Ground Handling Agent (GHA) waits **10 minutes** to see if the issue resolves.

### ✈ If error persists after 10 minutes, you have to:

- Report the issue to TOCC.
- Raises a fault log in **TAGO** with the GoNow error.

### ✈ TOCC will confirm 10 minutes have passed and declare an outage:

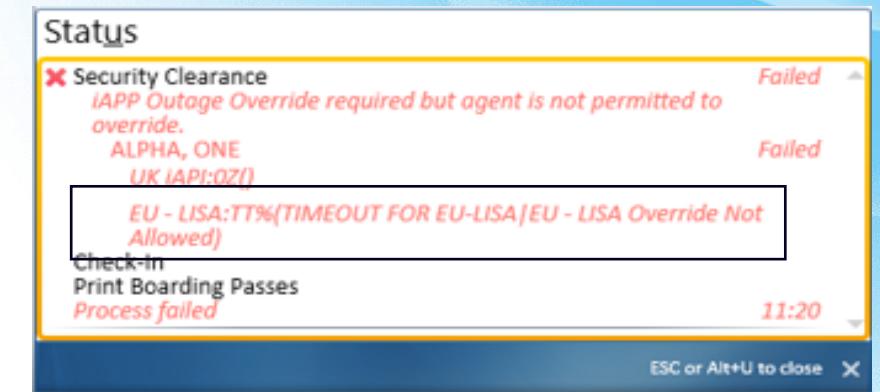
- Open COBST and raise a ticket.

### ✈ TOCC will put GoNow in Outage Mode for EES.

### ✈ TOCC will tell GHA to continue check-in without EES.

### ✈ TOCC monitors and updates COBST ticket until recovery.

### ✈ TOCC restores EES back into normal mode in GoNow.
