Dear partner,

There has been an **increase of hold baggage being misloaded and sent to the wrong destination**. Not only is this a big inconvenience to our customers but is also a security risk.

This is a **reminder** that the individual responsible for loading the aircraft must complete a final visual check of the baggage tags prior to the commencement of loading to confirm that all baggage tags correspond to the correct destination and align with the flight details.

If, as the receiving station, you offload a hold bag that was for another destination, please submit a **Safety Report via IQSMS**.
