
Dear partner,

As of 01.07.24 there will be a change in entering Pantry codes in eLoadsheets, applicable for all X3 in- and outbound flights (for all German registered aircrafts).

We will deselect the random Pantry Code 'A', which will force the load controller to select the correct code for every flight, based on the destination, available in the DOW/I tables.

This must be done in the following way:

- 1) Check the destination of the flight and pick up the correct Pantry Code in the DOW/I pages in the TAGO Portal
- 2) Go to eLoadsheets and update the correct Pantry Code in "Advanced" tab in the top right of the screen



- Select Pantry from the drop down, and select the correct code, which applies to the handled routing.

- 3) When ready, don't forget to hit "Save" and always confirm the DOW/I with the crew!!
