



Topic: Prohibited Items In Checked Baggage And Handbag At The Check-In Counter And At The Gate

Dear All

I would like to remind you, that the prohibited items sign must be displayed at all check-in counters and boarding gates.

At the Check-In

All customers need to be asked to check the sign, and confirm that they don't carry any prohibited items. Even if they have no checked baggage, but a carry-on only.

The sign has 3 parts:

- First the prohibited items are listed – both checked baggage and carry-on,
- then the items (e.g. power bank, e-cigarettes, laptop batteries, etc.) which can travel in the carry-on only,
- and lastly the items that can travel on one's person only: matches or lighter.

At the Gate

Once you checked in a handluggage at the gate, this handluggage becomes a "checked baggage", and different rules apply. Since this bag is no longer a handbag, but travels in the hold of the aircraft, all items that can be transported in the handluggage only must be removed (power bank, e-cigarettes, laptop batteries, etc.)!

Furthermore, the customers need to be asked to remove any items they might need on board or before collecting the bag from the carousel, such as medications, passport, etc.


When checking in bags at the gate, the sign must be referred to as well, and the customer needs to confirm that those items have been removed.







****If you have not prepared your luggage, left your luggage unattended, or if you don't carry your baggage, please inform our staff immediately!*

Note: One box of matches OR one gas lighter can be carried on the person but are not allowed in the hold baggage.

Make sure you don't carry any prohibited items!



Passengers and Cabin Baggage - LIST OF PROHIBITED ARTICLES

Without prejudice to applicable safety rules, passengers are not permitted to carry the following articles into security restricted areas and on board an aircraft:

a) Guns, firearms and other devices that discharge projectiles - devices capable, or appearing capable, of being used to cause serious injury by discharging a projectile, including:

Firearms of all types - Pistols, revolvers, rifles, shotguns - toy guns, replicas and imitation firearms capable of being mistaken for real weapons - component parts of firearms excluding telescopic sights - compressed air and CO₂ guns - pellet guns - rifles and ball bearing guns - signal flare and starter pistols - bows, cross bows and arrows - harpoon and spear guns - slingshots and catapults.

b) Stunning devices - devices designed specifically to stun or immobilise, including:

Devices for shocking such as stun guns, tasers and stun batons - animal stunners and animal killers, disabling and incapacitating chemicals, gases and sprays, such as mace, pepper sprays, capsicum sprays, tear gas, acid sprays and animal repellent sprays.

c) Objects with a sharp point or sharp edge - objects with a sharp point or sharp edge capable of being used to cause serious injury, including:

Items designed for chopping, axes, hatchets and cleavers - ice picks and axes, razor blades - box cutters - knives with blades of more than 6 cm - scissors with blades of more than 6 cm as measured from the fulcrum - martial arts equipment with a sharp point or sharp edge - swords and sabres.

d) Workmen's tools - tools capable of being used either to cause serious injury or to threaten the safety of aircraft, including:

Crowbars - drills and drill bits including cordless portable power drills - tools with a blade or a shaft of more than 6 cm capable of use as a weapon such as screwdrivers and chisels - saws, including cordless portable power saws - blowtorches, bolt guns and nail guns.

e) Blunt instruments - objects capable of being used to cause injury when used to hit, including:

Baseball and softball bats - clubs and batons - billy clubs, blackjack and night sticks - martial arts equipment.

f) Explosives and incendiary substances and devices capable, or appearing capable, of being used to cause serious injury or to pose a threat to the safety of aircraft, including:

Ammunition - blasting caps - detonators and fuses - replica or imitation explosive devices - mines, grenades and other explosive military stores - fireworks and other pyrotechnics - smoke-generating canisters and smoke-generating cartridges - dynamite, gunpowder and plastic explosives.

g) Damaged or tampered lithium batteries and devices.

The following dangerous goods are also completely exempt from transportation as cabin or hold baggage:

Butane lighter gas - lighter fuel - blue flame or cigar lighters - strike anywhere matches - bleach - peroxide - poison - oxygen generators - radioactive material;

Corrosive materials like acids, mercury and wet cell batteries as well as filled scuba diving bottles - fuel containers and camping stoves which are not emptied and cleaned;

Dry ice in quantities of more than 2,5 kg per person and strong magnets - combustion engines and flammable materials like paint, lacquers and solvents;

Security-type brief case or attaché cases incorporating lithium batteries or pyrotechnical devices.

Note: One box of matches OR one gas lighter can be carried on the person but are not allowed in the hold baggage.

Please note: The lithium battery/powerbank must be removed before bag drop if carried as hold luggage

- Si suggerisce di portare i dispositivi elettronici alimentati da batterie a litio nel bagaglio a mano
- Le sigarette elettroniche, i power banks e le batterie di ricambio DEVONO ESSERE PORTATI SOLO NEL BAGAGLIO A MANO
- Se è necessario imbarcare il vostro tablet, cellulare o laptop nel bagaglio da stiva, assicurarsi che siano completamente spenti (non in modalità stand by o sleep)

1 It is best to pack lithium-powered devices and accessories into your carry-on bag

2 Electronic cigarettes, power banks and spare batteries MUST BE KEPT IN YOUR CARRY-ON BAG

3 If you must pack your tablets, mobile or laptop in your checked luggage, be sure they are completely turned off (not in "hibernate" or sleep modes)

NOTE: Watt-hours (Wh) are determined by multiplying the voltage (V) by the amp hours (Ah), i.e. $10 \times 5 \text{ Ah} = 50 \text{ Wh}$
