ACCEPTANCE OF DANGEROUS GOODS – Wheelchair/mobility aid non-removable lithium battery limitations



Purpose:

This bulletin outlines recent changes in Dangerous Goods Regulations to the acceptable capacity of wheelchair/mobility aid batteries.



- From October 29, 2025 wheelchairs or other mobility aids with a permanently installed, non-removable lithium battery will be subject to a limit of a maximum of two batteries, each with a capacity of up to 160 Wh.
- airBaltic approval is mandatory for transportation – no changes to existing procedures.
- Wheelchairs or mobility aids confirmed prior to October 1, 2025, that exceed the new 160 Wh limit will be accepted for transportation by airBaltic
