



Topic: About Visa Regime for Turkish Citizens Travelling to Montenegro

Dear Partners,

According to the decision taken by the Government of Montenegro, the visa-free regime for Turkish citizens has been temporarily suspended.

Based on the information obtained from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Montenegro, as of October 30, 2025, Turkish citizens holding ordinary passports will be subject to visa requirements when entering Montenegro.

On the other hand, persons holding passports and Montenegro residence permits valid for at least three (3) months, as well as valid and multiple-entry visas issued by Australia, Canada, Japan, New Zealand, Ireland, the United States of America, the United Kingdom, and Schengen Area countries, can enter Montenegro without obtaining a Montenegro visa, provided that their stay does not exceed 30 (thirty) days.

Holders of Diplomatic, Service, and Special Passports will continue to be exempt from visa requirements for their travels to Montenegro, provided that their stay does not exceed 90 days within a 180-day period.
