PAX DISCREPANCIES

There have been several incidents where boarding passes were not scanned correctly, resulting in passengers being on board without having been registered as scanned. This causes discrepancies between the actual number of passengers on board and the number shown in the system, leading to situations where passengers are offloaded in the system even though they are physically on board.
