
**iPort Document Verification**

Please carefully check the travel documents in iPort against the entry requirements:

Step 1: Click the colored square under API.



Step 2: In the popup you can swipe the travel document to add it to the system. Because the document must be verified manually you must ensure that the documents provided will be accepted for entry. To do this, click "Travel Doc."



The system will take the travel documents you have provided and check them against the entry requirements. Here the document requirements have been met, and the system shows a green check mark.
