Topic: Update on Carry-On Baggage Dimensions and Sizer Usage

Dear Partners,

We would like to inform you of an important update to our airline carry-on baggage sizers.

The approved carry-on baggage dimensions have been revised from $55 \times 40 \times 20$ cm to **$55 \times 40 \times 23$ cm** recently.

In line with this change, the baggage sizers currently in use, which are based on the former dimensions, will be withdrawn from service and should no longer be used at stations **effective immediately**.

As of now, carry-on baggage controls shall be conducted only based on weight and piece allowance.

No additional size checks with sizer are required for standard-size cabin baggage until further notice.

We kindly ask all stations and ground handling teams to ensure immediate implementation of this change and alignment across operations.

Existing baggage sizers will be withdrawn from use and should be sent back to SAW as soon as possible. Please keep SAWCOMAIL@flypgs.com informed for the flight details.
