Topic: United Kingdom Accompanied Child Visas – Acceptance Procedure Update

Dear all,

As of 14 January, passengers holding a UK Accompanied Child Visa can be accepted for travel even if they are not accompanied by the individual named on the visa, provided that all other travel and entry requirements are fully met.

In this regard, please ensure the following checks are carried out carefully:

- The visa is valid and genuine,
- The visa start and expiry dates are thoroughly checked,
- The passenger holds a valid passport.

Note: This announcement does not relate to UM (Unaccompanied Minor) or YP (Young Passenger) procedures implemented by our airline. It applies solely to travel document verification requirements.

We kindly request that this update be taken into consideration during passenger acceptance and document verification processes, and thank you for your attention and diligence.
