



## Topic: Passenger Acceptance Rules for Entry into Türkiye

Dear Colleagues,

In order to prevent irregularities identified during passenger acceptance for entry into Türkiye, the following rules must be **strictly and consistently applied** at all station

### ✓ **PASSPORT VALIDITY**

- All passengers travelling to Türkiye must have a passport valid for **more than 61 days from the date of entry**.
- Passengers who do not meet this requirement **must not be accepted for travel**.

### ✓ **TIMATIC CHECKS**

- If the TIMATIC system returns a **"NO"** response:
  - The check-in process must not be completed by entering any description in the *Explanation* field.
- A negative TIMATIC result **must not be overridden**.
- In case of any doubt or uncertainty, **please consult @PEGASUSVISA before proceeding**.

### ✓ **E-VISA VERIFICATION**

When accepting passengers travelling with an e-Visa, the following checks are mandatory:

- All information shown on the e-Visa (**name, surname, passport number, date of birth**) must **exactly match** the details in the passenger's passport.
- For **single-entry e-Visas**:
  - It must be verified whether the visa has been previously used by checking **entry stamps inside the passport**.
  - Passengers presenting a **single-entry visa that has already been used** must **not be accepted for travel**.
- The **visa validity start and end dates** must be carefully checked; visas outside their validity period are not acceptable.
- The **Supporting Document** section on the e-Visa must be reviewed in detail.
  - Additionally, it must be confirmed that the passenger **is physically carrying the supporting document** stated on the e-Visa.
