# Topic: Kam Air Codeshare Flights – Passenger Acceptance Rules

Dear Partners,

In accordance with the codeshare agreement between **Pegasus Airlines and Kam Air (RQ)**, the following points should be taken into consideration regarding passengers traveling to **KBL and MZR**.

ü Passengers with onward Kam Air flights are displayed on the DCS check-in screen as follows.

- Passengers Connecting to Kam Air Flights via SAW:** Passengers holding the same PNR with onward flights to KBL or MZR are not required to enter Türkiye. These passengers may remain in the transit area of SAW Airport and proceed to their onward flights. A Turkish visa is not required.
- Passengers Eligible for Visa-Free Entry to Afghanistan:** Passengers meeting any of the following conditions are exempt from obtaining a visa for entry into Afghanistan:
  - Being born in Afghanistan,
  - Holding Afghan nationality originally,
  - Having a parent who is an Afghan citizen.
    - Note:** If the passenger is not traveling together with their Afghan parent, an **OK TO BOARD** approval issued by the operating airline (Kam Air) must be obtained prior to the flight.
- Travel with Refugee Passports:** There are frequent inquiries regarding passengers holding refugee travel documents issued by European countries. For such passengers, the same Afghanistan entry rules outlined above apply without exception.
