PETC (Pet in cabin)	PBM 2.4.2	<p>Must be pre-booked and fee charged, never be seated in front row or exit seats Max. 6 PETC per flight and 10 kgs including cage (PET max. 8 kgs) Dimension: 40x20x24 cm; must fit under the front seat; both soft and hard case acceptable, must be waterproof Cats, dogs, birds, rabbits, ferrets and hamster (TIMATIC for destination requirements to be checked) Dogs, cats and ferrets requires PET passport</p>
SVAN (Service Animal in cabin)	PBM 2.4.2.5	<p>With BLND, DEAF and MUTE pax Only dogs with PET passport and prove of correct assistand dog documentation (!) - For SVAN to UK check ITA PBM 2.4.2.5.1 for detailed information and further requirements No charge and no weight restriction The following prerequisites apply:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The dog must be leashed and owner holds a muzzle (to be used if needed) • A seat adjacent to PRM will be assigned to grant space for the dog and to not disturb other passenger (always aisle seat and never at an Emergency Exit!). • The passenger shall be in possession of all necessary animal health documents. • PIC and Cabin Crew will be informed of blind passenger plus guide dog prior boarding and the information shall be mentioned in the Passenger Information List (PIL) or Crew Information Sheet (where applicable). • In case Economy class is fully booked, passenger with guide dog can be upgraded in business class free of charge • Pre-boarding must be applied preferably.
AVIH (Animal in Hold)	PMB 2.4.2 & HLM	<p>Must be pre-booked and fee charged AVIH in transit: No overnight transit allowed, if transit time 12h+ AVIH must be collected by passenger and checked in again for next flight. For FRA transit boarding agents need to ensure, AVIH owner were boarded. Otherwise AVIH need to be off loaded! For more details refer to HLM.</p>

STCR (Stretchers)	PBM 6.2.7	1 per flight only with additional fee, seats 28-31 Y Need to have medical clearance and must be accompanied In case medical assistant required, escort must be physician or nurse
WCH* (Wheelchair)	IATA SSR Code table	WCHR: Requires wheelchair for distance to and from A/C only WCHS: Cannot ascend/descend stairs/steps but no assistance in A/C cabin necessary WCHC: Passenger totally immobile and need full assistance up to A/C seat
WCMP (Wheelchair - Manual Power)	PBM 6.2.12.3.2	WCMP must be used in combination with WCH* Must be loaded into the hold (Except of A330 A/C: Limited space in cabin available)
BLND, DEAF, MUTE, DPNA	PBM 6.2.12.1 & 6.2.12.2	Passenger is blind/deaf/mute or intellectual/developmental disabled needing assistance. Check if escort required.
MEDA (Medical Assistant)	PBM 6.2.6	Medical case: Medical certificate required. Not to be used for passengers who only require special assistance and do not require medical clearance.
EMA (Electric Mobility Aid) Subject to Dangerous Goods Regulations, accounted for Load Control and reported to the Flight Captain!	PBM 6.2.12.3.2	WCBD: Dry cell battery WCLB: Lithium ion battery WCBW: Wet cell battery May be accepted after further checks of requirements for safe air transportation. Dangerous Goods Regulations and Loading requirements to be checked before acceptance of any EMA!
DAA (Delivery at Aircraft)		Not used in FRA
DEPA (Accompanied Deportee) - Captain and Cabin crew to be informed	PBM 10.1 & 15.1.6	To be seated in the last rows (window seats) with a minimum of 2 escorts Potentially Disruptive Passengers, who need to be escorted by police or security agents
DEPU (Unescorted Deportee) Captain and Cabin crew to be informed	PBM 10.1 & 15.1.6	DEPU must not exceed the number of designated flight attendants To be seated in last rows (window seat)
INAD (Inadmissible Passenger) Captain and Cabin crew to be informed	PBM 9.2	Do not have the right to enter a specific country and are therefore returned to the country of origin The documentation relative to the INAD to be delivered to the Flight Captain prior to boarding. In case of a dangerous/disruptive INAD the ITA Security department to be contacted/informed
WEAP (Weapon)	PBM 2.4.6	Firearms (FRMS) and ammunition (AMMO) Firearms unloaded, dismantled and packed into special closed containers - max 15 kg Ammunition packed separately in appropriate metal, wood or fibre container provided with safety locks - not exceeding 5 kg BuPOL to be called for assistance at check-in Firearm and Ammunition stickers must be used.

Snow and skiing equipment	A pair of snow-skis, a pair of sticks and a pair of ski-boots or, a snowboard, a pair of boots or, a complete kite snow equipment
Water skiing equipment	A pair of standard water-skis or a slalom water-ski.
Golf equipment	A golf bag including golf clubs, balls and one pair of golf shoes.
Polo equipment	A set of polo mallets.
Scuba, diving equipment	mask, snorkel, fins, neoprene suit, GAV, regulator, an empty oxygen tank, a lamp (switched off, with the power packed separately, the batteries disconnected from the appliance and protected against shortcircuits). Any underwater speargun should have the spear section separated and if gas-powered should be unloaded.
Fishing equipment	2 fishing rods, one fishing-reel, a small net, a pair of fishing boots and a bait box or a haversack
Fencing equipment	A bag containing a uniform, a cuirass armour, a mask, blades
Tennis/squash/badminton equipment	A single bag containing one set of tennis rackets and balls only
Archery equipment	A bag containing a bow, arrows, quiver, gloves and aiming equipment

Tipologia di attrezzatura sportiva: BIG	Descrizione
Bicycle	- a normal bicycle (with no motor, not an e-bike), single seater, suitably secured with rigid packaging, with the handlebars fixed laterally, the pedals removed and the tyres completely deflated. - para-bicycle.
Tandem	with no motor (not an e-bike), suitably secured with rigid packaging, with the handlebars disassembled or fixed laterally, the pedals removed and the tires completely deflated
Surfboard	a shortboard type surfboard
Windsurf and longboards	a windsurfing board, a sail, a mast, a boom, a waterproof bag; a longboard-type board
Canoe/Kayak	a canoe or kajak (with no motor), two paddles

Instruments	PBM 2.4.4	Can be carried in cabin instead of standard cabin baggage or as CBBG For instruments exceeding cabin bag size, an extra seat (EXST) to be purchased
EXST (Extra seat)		Extra seat is available for purchase for PAP comfort (mostly purchased for oversized passenger, instruments, wedding dresses etc)
CBBG (Cabin baggage)	PBM 2.4.3.1	Max 55 kgs, combined with a purchased EXST Window seat for the cabin baggage
INFT (Infant)	PBM 7.1.	< 2 yrs old Limit: depends on Aircraft type Only 1 infant per adult (18yrs+) is allowed For Car Seats refer to PBM 7.1.2.1
CHLD (Child)	Website	2-14 yrs old; Must be seated with accompanying adult, parent, or Guardian otherwise UMN service is required and must be paid.
YPTA (Young Traveller)	??	No YPTA: "Voluntary Unaccompanied Minor" Service for children 15-17yrs for additional fee - see below Voluntary UMN

UMNR (Unaccompanied Minor) Note: If UMNR is over 12 modify passenger category from C (child) to A (adult) for weight and ballance purposes	PBM 8.1	<p>5-14 years old (UM service even when escorted by a person <18yrs)</p> <p>Limit: 7% of cabin capacity (for school groups 1 escort per 12 minors) must be assigned an aisle seat starting from the rear. In case of more than one UMNR, try to keep them together and try to seat them close to family with children. In case of booked INAD/DEPO (seating in the rear) assign an aisle seat in the front of A/C to UMNR.</p> <p>UM envelope must contain following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ticket / Boarding passes • Filled in AFFIDAVIT form (copy to be kept for 2 years on the station) • 3 copies for direct flights (1 x parents, 1 x departing station, 1 x arriving station) • 2 extra copies for EACH connecting station • Passport + VISA and Vaccination certificate if applicable) <p>ATTN: No stop-overs to be booked for UM !</p>

Pregnancy	PBM 6.2.11 & Website	<p>Single, uncomplicated.</p> <p>Medical certificate not required</p> <p>Can travel until 4 weeks prior to expected birth</p> <p>Medical Information Form (MEDIF) and doctors "fit to fly" certificate required if:</p> <p>In the last 4 weeks of pregnancy</p> <p>Medical complications</p> <p>If twins are expected</p>
