

Topic: Overnight Stays in LIN – Do Not Through Check Luggage

Dear all,

Passengers flying to LIN with a connecting flight scheduled for the next day must have their luggage checked only to LIN.

For example, PAX with the routing:

25JUL AZ419 FRA-LIN
26JUL AZ1763 LIN-PMO

Because the connecting flight is the next day, their luggage needs to be checked in only to LIN. Please inform passengers to collect their luggage from baggage claim in LIN and check it in again the following day for their next flight.

In Altea when adding a bag select the appropriate destination (LIN) by clicking the dropdown under the “To” option.
