just wanted to explain you short what manual check in and boarding actually is. As the name already says. This type of process is when our system completely doesn't work. So, we need to have any Plan B.

Manual Check in and Boarding works without any system, we need to just prepare some sheets and check the passengers in. In this process we need to be 100% sure that the passengers which we are accepting are flying with us. So, we need the tickets and like the normal process the documents of them.

What we need for the Manual Check in and Boarding:

- Pen
- Passenger manifest/check in sheet
- Passenger names list
- Passenger information list (PIL)
- Seat plan/map
- Bingo card
- Manual bag tags
- Boarding cards





For accepting bags, we will have manual tags as you know which we are using them for Pegasus (Green Tags) but in this case we will use our DHS ones or prepared from the airport. We need to fill the bag tags completely with all the flight information's. The tag looks like this.



For the final is it important to know at the end how many bags we accepted in total. For this we need to use the Bingo Sheets, where we need to put the small tags (only 1) on the sheet. At the end we can just tell the TRC how many bags we accepted in total.







For the boarding pass we need to use blank boarding passes where you need to write down the main things which you learned during the training,

Name, Flight Number, Security, Date, Gate, Seat (everybody will get rows for the seats, so no double seating will be ensured).

At the end the last step, Boarding:

We will have a prepared boarding list with all security numbers for example 1-239. Each passenger who will board, we need to tick the security number on the sheet, at the end we can just count, how many passengers we have.
