Procedure for Afghan Nationals Holding a Pakistan E-Visa

Dear Partners,

Recently, there has been an increase in **INAD** cases involving **Afghan nationals** and **passengers born in Afghanistan** who are attempting to travel to Pakistan with an **e-visa**.

Therefore, for Afghan nationals or passengers born in Afghanistan who hold a **Pakistan medical e-visa** or a **student e-visa**, it is **mandatory to obtain prior approval before accepting them for travel**.

To obtain prior approval, please send an email with the relevant passenger documents to [**PEGASUSVISA@flypgs.com**](mailto:PEGASUSVISA@flypgs.com) or contact our team via **WhatsApp support line** before accepting the passenger on board.

Note: To avoid any complications, it is **crucial that this procedure is followed completely and carefully**. Passengers without prior approval **must not** be accepted for travel.
