



## Topic: About Cabin Baggage

Dear Partners,

With the technological advancements and digitalization in the aviation, ground handling processes have significantly transitioned to online systems, resulting in faster operational procedures, increased passenger satisfaction, and reduction on physical materials.

As part of these developments, the cabin baggage tagging process will be discontinued as of May 1. From this date forward, cabin baggage checks will be performed without usage of cabin tags.

At the check-in counters, passengers' cabin baggage allowances will be verified through the system, and weight and size checks will be performed before approval. Similarly, at the gate during pre-boarding and boarding stages, passengers' cabin baggage allowances will be verified through their boarding passes and system checks, with size control conducted before acceptance for flight.

Payment procedures for non-compliant baggage and the manual tagging process for baggage transfers to the aircraft hold will continue as usual. After May 1, stations holding excess stock may return unused tags.
