TOPIC: *Changes to baggage pricing at airports*

Dear Team,

Changes to pricing of bags are made starting from **8 April 2025**. The logic of pricing is changed to time-to-departure model. The baggage prices will increase 6 days, 48 hours and 6 hours before departure. The earlier the extra baggage is purchased, the cheaper the price. The pricing will increase also related to the number of bags instead of flat price per piece for short haul flights, whereas previously it was only used for long haul flights. The price increases at airports apply to baggage sold via Altéa CM.

The prices will be published on 8 April, on Finnair webpage - Extra baggage fees, linked below.

Prices increased for following baggage types on all travel areas

- Heavy, oversized and heavy & oversized
- Skis (SKIS), golf bags (GOLF) and surf boards (SURF) as follows the same pricing as checked bag.

Journeys within Finland, Scandinavia and Baltics

- Superlight fare: Carry-on bag (CAOB)

- All ticket types: 2nd and 3rd checked baggage

Journeys within the rest of Europe

- Superlight fare: Carry-on bag (CAOB)
- Business Light / Economy Superlight: 1st, 2nd & 3rd checked bag
- All other ticket types: 2nd and 3rd checked bag

Journeys between North America and Europe

- All light fares (Business, Premium Economy, Economy): 1st, 2nd and 3rd checked bag
- Economy Classic and Flex: 2nd and 3rd checked bag
- Premium Economy Classic and Flex & Business Classic and Flex: 3rd checked bag

Journeys to/from Asia and the Middle East

- All light fares (Business, Premium Economy, Economy): 2nd and 3rd checked bag
- Economy Classic and Flex: 2nd and 3rd checked bag
- Premium Economy Classic and Flex & Business Classic and Flex: 3rd checked bag

Journeys between Japan and Europe

- All light fares (Business, Premium Economy, Economy): 2nd, 3rd and 4th checked bag
- Economy Classic and Flex: 2nd and 3rd checked bag
- Premium Economy Classic and Flex & Business Classic and Flex: 3rd checked bag
