Dear partners, please be remained!

Upgrade to Business class policy applicable for Captains and First officers has been implemented and is effective as of **August 15, 2017**

Captains and First Officers traveling on any of airBaltic flight as staff on **duty** or **leisure** may request and may be upgraded, if:

- 1) Presents themselves at the gate in full airBaltic uniform: 2) Presents a Crewmember certificate:



3 stripes for First Officer

4 stripes for Captain

**WHEN:**

- Only at the gates before boarding process;
- Upgrades can be performed in case of C-class seats are available and upgrade process will not cause any flight irregularities;
- In case of overbooked Y-class, DCS acceptance list nr.17 must be followed (or as suggested by Irregularities team). And only after commercial passengers accepted, captain and / or first officer request can be handled.

DIVIDERS:

- No divider change due to upgrade requests;
- In case of full economy class configuration - upgrades are not possible.

PRIORITY:

- Defined according position and seniority in the company:
 - Captain (if 2 captains – according to seniority)
 - First officer (more than one – according to seniority)
- Position (captain or first officer) to be clarified by the gate agent
- Seniority determined based on date of employment (visible on crewmember certificate)

NB! Pilots has to be at the gate before boarding starts and apply for the upgrade at the gate. Upgrades handling cannot be a reason for flight delay.

Regrade to C cabin reason *Staff* shall be indicated.
