DESCRIPTION:

We remind you that according to LO08 IATA LAR

LO08 Dangerous dogs

The following dangerous dog breeds will be accepted for carriage in accordance with the requirements of the CR82 container

American Pitbull

Japanese Tosa

Pit Bull Terrier

Dogos Argentinos

American Staffordshire Terrier

*Puppies aged 2-6 months can be accepted for transport in accordance with the requirements of the CR1 container

As of June 26, 2023, we are introducing the following additional dog breeds to the above-mentioned list of breeds requiring the use of a CR82 container:

Staffordshire Bull Terrier,
American Pit Bull Terrier,
American Bully,
Karabash / Kangal,
Cavcasian Shepherd;
Rottweiler'
Bullterrier,
Majorca Dog,

The requirement to use the CR82 container also applies to crosses of the above-mentioned breeds.
