<u>Slips, Trips & Falls</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ It is important to mitigate the risk of slips, trips and falls by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Ensuring that equipment is free from contamination ▪ Being aware of slip risks when working around aircraft that have been de-iced ▪ Self-help equipment such as shovels, brooms, grit or de-icing crystals spreaders should be made available by the Airport Authority and positioned on aircraft stands to allow personnel to make work areas and passenger walkways safe, free from snow and ice 	Winter Operations Manual – Various sections
