<u>Slips, Trips & Falls</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">> We are seeing a high volume of safety reports concerning slippery steps. Always Ensure:<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Equipment is free of contamination▪ Ensure passenger and staff walkways are clear of contamination▪ Be aware of possible de-icing fluid on steps, stands and walkways▪ If an area or piece of equipment is deemed as unsafe, ensure that it is reported immediately	Winter Operations Manual (WOM)
<u>Bags loaded above the line</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">> As ski season continues, some flights will see an increased number of booked hold baggage, always ensure that baggage is loaded below the loading "MAX LOADING HEIGHT LINE" 	GHM 4.5.6.4 – Loading Procedures
<u>Guard rails on steps</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">> Prior to boarding Ground Crew must always check that passenger doors are open and guard rails at the top of the steps are in place and secure	GHM 3.1.3.6 – Passenger Stairs
<u>Spot of the month</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">> Well done to Antonin in BOD who spotted a screw in a tyre. This was reported to the crew and engineers and resulted in a tyre change	GHM – Various sections
