Dear All

I would like to share latest MEMO from Pegasus Airlines Visa Team about Saudi Arabia. These flights will indeed be more complicated when it comes to visa checks especially during Hajj.

I would like to ask you all, please ask Visa Team all the time when you have passengers to Saudi Arabia. Even if it seems to be okay, and you have a green response.

2 days ago Hamburg had an INAD because when the passenger showed up at the counter the visa seemed to be valid and everything was green, but when the passenger arrived to Istanbul Pegasus Airlines denied the passenger, because it turned out that the visa was in the meantime cancelled.

With this example I would like to highlight, that these Saudi Arabia cases are going to be complicated, please always seek help from the Pegasus Visa team!

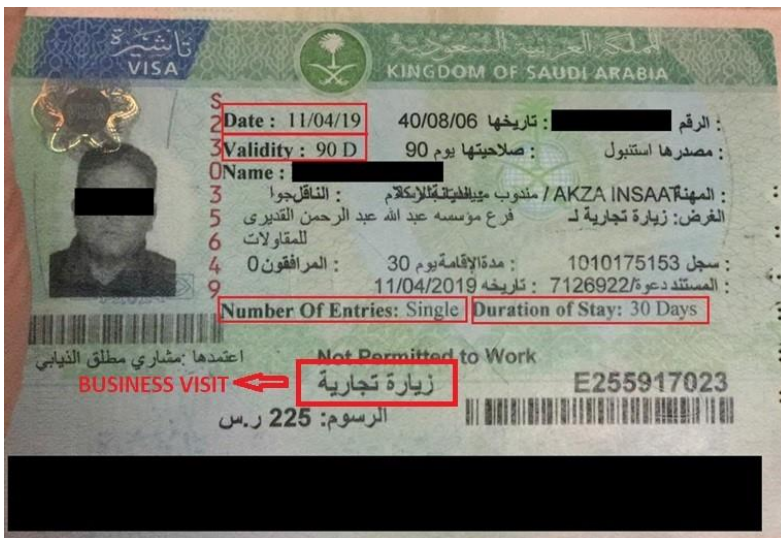
Dear Partners,

Dated **June 4th 2023**;

On **JED (Jeddah)-MED (Medinah)-DMM (Dammam)-RUH (Riyadh)** flights that we operate as **Pegasus Airlines**, we have passengers whose starting point is your station.

Before accepting the passengers on **Saudi Arabia** flight, we kindly request that the documents are **checked carefully** and the **attached presentation is examined** and that the passengers who do not meet the travel rules are not accepted to the flights.

We have determined that there have been problems with **Sticker type visas** so far. For your convenience, you **can find examples of visas that are not accepted** for certain types of **JED (Jeddah) and MED (Medinah) flights**.



(Umrah visas will not be accepted after June 2nd, 2023)

We ask for your **cooperation** on the subject and **wish you good work.**
