

Topic: About Restricted Schengen Visas

Dear Partners,

We would like to remind you of the (-) phrase in Schengen visas.

In Schengen visas issued by any Schengen member country, if there are countries **marked with a (-) sign in the “valid for” section, this means that that visa is not valid in the relevant countries.**

The Schengen visa, an example of which you can see below, is issued by the French authority. **ETATS SCHENGE -(DK)** means that this visa cannot be used to enter **Denmark**. The visa in the example provides the right to enter all Schengen countries except Denmark. **For this reason, the countries in parentheses, if any, should be checked completely during visa checks on Schengen flights.**
