



Topic: TUI EMA

Dear All,

As part of our commitment to efficient and safe handling practices for TUI, it is imperative that we all adhere to the following procedures concerning EMAs:

1. During the Check in all electric WCHs should be tagged with an EMA tag and you should be informed.
2. **On-Ramp Procedures:**
 - Loadmaster must fasten electric wheelchairs according to GHM 9.1.4.5 guidelines securely.
 - **Complete the EMA tag in its entirety:**
 - Specify the compartment designation.
 - Indicate whether the battery remains attached or has been removed for cabin storage.
 - completed EMA tag needs to be signed by Loadmaster about the loading location.
3. **EMA - tag Copies:**
 - Each EMA tag comprises three copies:
 - One copy for the Captain.
 - One copy for our records, to be filed in the flight file promptly.
 - The remaining copy is to be left with the WCH.

It is crucial that these procedures are followed diligently to ensure the safe and efficient handling of electric mobility aids.
