When editing flights please check the outbound connections for anyone connecting via train and add a next time comment that their luggage should only be checked to FCO.

7) INTERMODAL ITINERARIES ARRIVING AT FCO and connecting to trains

For passengers arriving at FCO airport by air and continuing by Trenitalia Alta Velocità Freccia Rossa or Freccia Argento procedure requires that baggage is always tagged only to FCO and transferred by the customer on his/her own to the station. Therefore, although 9B connections should not appear in the PNRs of Intermodal Customers, check-in operators of network stations should always make sure that the baggage is tagged only to FCO.
