


Topic: In-Cabin Live Animal Acceptance Checklist

Dear all,

In accordance with IATA regulations it is required to complete an acceptance checklist when accepting live animals to the cabin. This includes PETC, SVAN, and ESAN.

ITA, Pegasus, and AirBaltic all have their own form. For LOT, Corendon, and HiSky the original IATA form is to be used.

Remember, if any question is answered with "NO", the PETC is not eligible for travel. However, for SVAN and ESAN some questions may not be applicable, e.g. container size.

The completed and signed form should be kept and stored with the gate report after the flight.
