

Topic: About Belgium Travel Rules

Dear Partners,

We would like to inform you about the points to be considered during the document checks of the passengers who will travel to Belgium.

The information on the residence cards of all Schengen countries and the information on the passports of the passengers using those cards must be exactly the same.

- 1) The name and surname on the residence card must be exactly the same as in the passport.
- 2) If the residence card has been taken as a result of asylum, there are phrases on the residence card showing that the passenger is a refugee. These phrases differ for each Schengen country. The relevant passengers cannot have a normal country passport, and the Asylum/Refugee passport must be with them. In short, the passenger can only travel with a passport that supports the residence card application for what purpose.

Examples of refugee residence cards for some Schengen countries are as follows. These passengers must present the refugee passports of the country in which they hold a residence card.
